Dues in the St. George Area Chamber of Commerce are based on the number of employees at the time of renewal, the time of sign-up for existing businesses, or the anticipated number of employees at the time of a business start-up.

Your dues may vary each year based on the number of Full Time Equivalent (FTE) employees that you have. Please take time to check the number of employees you have, and enter it accurately on the application or invoice and the appropriate dues amount based on the number of FTE's you have. **Two part time employees equal one full time employee.**
